

Instructions for scientific communications

Each person that registers can submit one abstract, during registration the prefer type of presentation must be selected. There are two types of scientific communications: Oral presentation and Poster presentation. The organizing committee will decide the signation of each abstract, this decision is final and unappealable.

If a non-member wishes to present a scientific communication, the work must be patronage by a member. This information must be explicit in the abstract submitted.

Oral presentation

This format allows the speaker to present the scientific research (10 min) which is immediately followed by 5 minutes of Q&A.

Authors may choose to display a presentation as a ppt or PDF. Please, include a first slice with the title, author list, affiliation, and funding. The presentation content must be in English.

All the oral presentations will be displayed using a computer provided by the SBBMCh, thus the author must be ready to change the format in case is incompatible.

Poster presentation

This format allows the speaker to present the scientific research as a poster during a special section of the Annual Meeting. This section is dedicated for interaction and active discussion between the speaker and the attendees. In addition, poster could be visited by the attendees during the meeting encouraging networking.

Authors must prepare a printed poster. including the following sections: Title, Introduction, Methods, Results, Conclusions and Funding. References and acknowledgment may also be included. Poster content must be in English.

At the top of your poster include the title, author list and affiliation in the same format you used in the submitted abstract. Please, include bellow the e-mail address of the speaker (the person presenting the poster).

The text, illustrations, etc. should be large enough to be read easily from two meters' distance. We recommend the usage of basic fonts like Arial or Verdana.

The following font sizes are recommended:

- The Title should be at least 84 point
- Section headers should be at least 48 point
- Body text should be at least 24 point

The dimensions of the poster board are: 90 cm wide x 110 cm long. The suggested final dimensions for posters are 90 cm wide x 100 cm long.

Please note that authors are responsible for hanging the poster early on the day of presentation. Authors are also responsible of removing the poster when indicated.

Please refer to the Final Program for the assignation of the poster number. There will be a board with the number on the poster room.

All necessary materials needed to hang up the posters will be provided by the SBBMCh and available on the poster room.
